The Kickstarter campaign [NeoLucida](#) brings this technique back to this time. The super-light model uses exactly the same technology as its predecessor 200 years old, as the [video](#) shows. Also, use the camera as a standard, but it is much less cool.

Then just the success: in three days took the initiative almost \$ 100,000, seven times as much as their goal. The gadget went out the door for \$ 30, but is now sold out. For fast backer with the big stock market is still one tickets available for NeoLucida Workshop. The \$ 3,500 you pay for it, will fix including a copy.
